



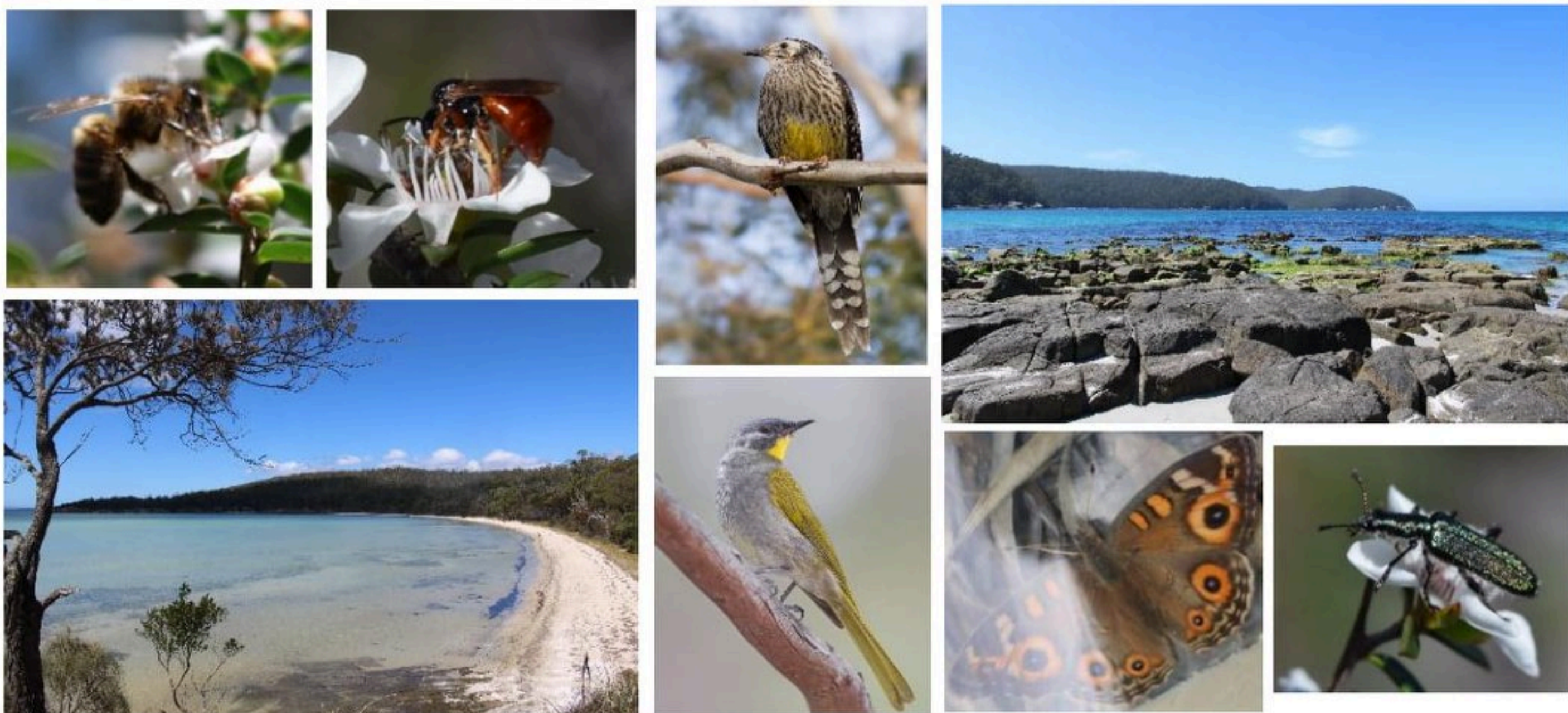
Would you like to learn to identify Tasmanian birds and insects, all the while visiting some iconic Tassie landscapes?
